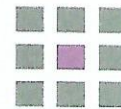

HEALTH AND SAFETY GENERAL STATEMENT

The practice recognises and accepts the responsibility:

- To provide a safe place of work.

The practice shall provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and safe systems of work for all its employees and shall also provide such information, training, instruction and supervision, as its employees need to comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act etc. 1974 and all other relevant regulations.



The practice will take such measures as are reasonably practicable to attain and maintain safe working procedures relating to the following:

- A safe place of work;
- The safe use of equipment;
- Safe arrangements for the storage, handling, transport and use of materials, etc. used at work including an assessment of the risks;
- The practice shall make the necessary arrangements, with regards to health and safety, to the nature of the practice's activities for the effective planning, organisation, control, monitoring and review of the preventative and protective measures, and also record the arrangements which should be made readily available for reference by all employees.

A copy of this health and safety general statement will be displayed in each office.

The allocation of duties and responsibilities for safety matters and the particular arrangements which have been made to implement this policy are set out in the practice's health and safety policy.

This health and safety policy will be monitored, reviewed and kept up to date, particularly as the practice changes in nature and size and any changes in legislation. The policy and the management of health and safety will be reviewed on at least an annual basis. The responsibility for monitoring this policy lies with Mr Gordon Clark.
